PUBLIC BIDDING No. 20 – 022– 3

CONSTRUCTION OF ASCOM FACILITIES AT CAMP AQUINO, TARLAC FOR THE BASES CONVERSION AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY

Issued pursuant to Sec. 22.5 of the IRR of R.A. 9184 to clarify and/or amend¹ certain provisions in the Bidding Documents issued for this project, considering the issues raised and clarifications made by prospective bidders during the **Pre-Bid Conference** held on **14 August 2020**, likewise, respond to bidders' written queries received within the prescriptive period for filing.

I. Clarifications:

REFERENCE/AMENDMENT	JUSTIFICATION/ EXPLANATION
Is there any tapping point for water and power supply in the existing camping nearby the site? And what is the distance.	<p>The Contractor may tap to the existing power and deep well lines within the project site, provided that a separate sub-meter will be installed at the expense of the Contractor, subject to the approval of the 1st Installation Management Battalion (1IMB), being the Camp Administrator and NOLCOM who manage the utilities inside the Camp.</p> <p>Considering the low water pressure from the existing deep well lines of the Camp, the Contractor may opt to put-up a deep well within the project site, subject to the approval of the Camp Administrator and NOLCOM.</p>

<p>Considering the proposed project is upgrading work of existing military camping, is there any mandatory rules and regulations within the site?</p>	<p>This is not an upgrading work of existing military camping but this is a new construction of ASCOM Facilities. The Camp Administrator will provide a simplified Camp Rules and Regulations applicable for the Contractor and its Workers. Also, the Contractor shall be briefed on the camp rules and regulations prior to the start of the construction.</p>

All other provisions of the bidding documents affected by this amendment are deemed modified or amended accordingly.

Amendments made herein shall be considered an integral part of the Bidding Documents.
