As discussed during Prebid Conference, if there is only one bidder who submitted a proposal, there will be a failure of Public Auction as provided in the COA CIRCULAR NO. 89-296 (5.2.a.1), to wit: 		
What if there is only one bidder who submitted a proposal?	 a. There was a failure of a public auction. As envisioned in this Circular, there is failure of public auction in any of the following instances: 		
	1. If there is only one offeror.		
	In this case, the offer or bid, if sealed, shall not be opened.		
	XXX		
	If several bidders joined and submitted their proposal, the award would be given to the highest bidder who complied with all the requirements. However, if there are several bidders who joined the auction and only one (1) bidder submitted a proposal for a particular lot, the same will be declared failure of bidding for that particular lot following the same provision as discussed above.
