### **PUBLIC BIDDING NO. 19-121-2**

DESIGN, DEVELOPMENT, INSTALLATION, CONFIGURATION, TESTING AND COMMISSIONING OF THE LRTA-INTEGRATED PEFORMANCE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (LRTA-IPMS) FOR THE LIGHT RAIL TRANSIT AUTHORITY (PART II)

Issued pursuant to Sec. 22.5 of the IRR of R.A. 9184 to clarify and/or amend<sup>1</sup> certain provisions in the Bidding Documents issued for this project, considering the issues raised and clarifications made by prospective bidders during the **Pre-Bid Conference** held on **17 May 2019**, likewise, respond to bidders' written queries received within the prescriptive period for filing.
