Our test result will be expiring on February 25, 2021, if we conduct another test, will this be constitute the confirmatory test of the first tranche of the delivery and the 6 month validity requirement.	Technical Specifications	Under BDS Clause 20.2 Item 6, bidder must submit valid test result within 2 months as a requirement prior to the opening of bids. Confirmatory Test however is being conducted during implementation stage as part of the inspection and acceptance. The two tests are being required separately.		
2.	With the FDA product registration, the Disinfectant Spray Category was deregulated in 2015. Our products are not required to register or renew previous Product Notification of Disinfectant Spray which expired in 2016. In 2020, there was a move from FDA to reinstate that product category.		The prospective bidder must submit a valid FDA certificate of product registration/notification.
