1	Can we print the logo directly in the box?	Section VII. Technical Specifications	Yes,
2	Can we print the logo in black and white color? If yes, can we also print our box in black & white color?	Section VII. Technical Specifications	The BAC explained that the prospective supplier may opt to choose either colored or black and white whichever is applicable.
3	In delivering to your end-users, can we ask the help of a third-party delivery service or a courier?	Section VI. Schedule of Requirements	The practice of other suppliers is that they apply the services of 3PL, it was not also mentioned in the bidding document that only their company delivery van/services will be used, as long as the items will be delivered to the end-users/agencies.

Or it could be at our discretion, given that it will still follow your requirements?	Section VII. Technical Specifications	<p>The BAC clarified that there is no specific size for the sticker. Likewise, the recommended sizes and designs of the sticker were presented.</p> <p>Please refer to Additional Requirements on Packaging and Marking/Labeling based on the TSRC Resolution No. TSRC 2021-001.</p>
5	If by any chance that we won this bidding; how many days would you send the specific design of the sticker from giving the Notice of Award?	Section VII. Technical Specifications	The specific design is already incorporated in the bidding document, please refer to Section VII. Technical Specifications, pages 40-41.
6	And would you give an extension if there had been an instance where we can't deliver the items on time? If yes, how many days would it be?	Section VI. Schedule of Requirements	<p>Delivery extension shall be approved by the Executive Director of the Procuring Entity.</p> <p>Per GPM Volume 2 Manual of Procedures for the Procurement of Goods and Services, page 108 states that:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>xxx</i></p> <p><i>"If delays are likely to be incurred, the supplier/ manufacturer/ distributor must notify the Procuring Entity in writing. It must state therein the cause/s and duration of the expected delay. The Procuring Entity may grant time extensions, at its discretion, if based on meritorious grounds, with or without liquidated damages.</i></p>

			<p><i>In all cases, the request for extension should be submitted before the lapse of the original delivery date. The maximum allowable extension shall not be longer than the initial delivery period as stated in the original contract."</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">xxx</p>
