- 20.2 For purposes of Post-qualification, the following document(s) shall be required:
 - 1. Latest Income Tax Returns for the year 2021 (BIR Form 1701 or 1702).
 - 2. Latest Value Added Tax Returns (Form 2550Q) or Percentage Tax Returns (Form 2551M). For this requirement, the latest VAT or Percentage tax returns shall cover the previous six (6) months prior to the deadline for submission of bids. For those with less than six (6) months of operations, this refers to the monthly business tax returns filed to date.

The income tax and business tax returns stated above should have been filed through the Electronic Filing and Payment System (EFPS). However, exceptions issued by the BIR are recognized subject to validation and verification.

- 3. Proof of completion of the SLCC as identified in the Statement of SLCC, which shall be a verifiable copy of the following documents:

- 8. Submission of pieces of evidence as proof of compliance with the bidder's actual offer, if applicable.

In the column "Bidder's Compliance", the bidder must state "comply" against each of the individual parameters of each specification corresponding to performance parameter of equipment offered. Statement of "comply" must be supported by evidence in a bidders bid and cross-referenced to that evidence. Evidence shall be in the form of manufacturer's or distributor's un-amended sales literature, unconditional statements or specification and compliance issued by the manufacturer or distributor, samples, independent test data etc., as appropriate.

	In case the PhilGEPS Certificate of Registration or any of the documents listed under its Annex A has expired after the bid opening, the bidder is required to submit the said documents anytime during the post-qualification stage.

Terms of Reference

Supply, Delivery, Installation, and Commissioning of 3.0TR Ceiling Cassette and 3.0HP Wall Mounted Inverter Type Air Conditioning Units for the Procurement Service-Department of Budget and Management (PS-DBM)

Objective

The Procurement Service - Department of Budget and Management (PS-DBM) intends to conduct the procurement for the Supply, Delivery, Installation, and Commissioning of 3.0TR Ceiling Cassette ACU and 3.0HP Wall Mounted Air Conditioning Units to replace existing ACUs within the PS-DBM Main Office and to accommodate the needs of PS-DBM employees and its clientele.

General Requirement

General Scope of Work

The work contemplated under this project shall consist of the furnishing of all materials, labor, tools, and equipment and the satisfactory performance to complete the Supply, Delivery, Installation, and Commissioning of the said ACUs. The project, upon completion, must be ready for use and must be under strict conformity with the Specifications of the project.

The principal items of works are enumerated below:

- 1. Supply, Delivery, Installation, and Commissioning of Five (5) units of 3.0TR Ceiling Cassette Inverter Type Air Conditioning Units;
- 2. Supply, Delivery, Installation, and Commissioning of Nine (9) units of 3.0HP Wall Mounted Inverter Type Air Conditioning Units
- Must be inclusive of installation of copper tubes, drain pipes and drain pumps (if applicable), supports and hangers which varies on the actual installation of the units; and
- 4. Chipping works and other concomitant works must be included.

Verification of Existing Condition

All contractors shall be allowed to visit the actual site of the project prior to the submission of their proposal.

No claim for extra compensation and time extension shall be entertained by PS-DBM for negligence or inadvertence on the Contractor's part in obtaining all necessary and pertinent data from the site.

Also, changes on layout or location of the ACUs may be done during the actual installation subject to the approval of the General Services Division (GSD).

Bidder's Eligibility Requirement

Contractor must be an authorized supplier, distributor, or partner of the air conditioning unit manufacturer. Contractor must also submit a copy of the manufacturer's product brochures, specifications sheet, manuals etc., (as appropriate) of all the required equipment. Moreover, the contractor must submit its bid proposal in accordance with the procedures and requirements indicated in the RA 9184 and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations.

Safety and Security

Safety

Contractor takes sole responsibility for the safety of the workers, inspectors, and PS-DBM Employees during the conduct of project implementation. Any accidents that may occur during project execution, through the fault of the contractor, will be under its liability. All workers of the contractor shall wear the necessary safety devices to ensure safety during construction.

Security and Identification Requirement

The Contractor is hereby required to comply the following during project implementation:

- 1. Submission of a complete list of names of all workers to be employed for the duration of the construction project.
- 2. All workers must adhere to the security policies of the PS-DBM.
- 3. All workers are required to wear company uniforms. Said uniform shall bear the company name and logo.
- 4. The company identification cards should be worn at all times when inside the PS-DBM Compound premises.

Other Requirements

The contractor shall coordinate with concerned personnel of the PS-DBM for the conduct of any activity related to the fulfillment of their obligations. Regular work can be performed from Mondays to Sundays, 8:00am to 5:00pm depending on the type of work subject to the discretion of the Officer-in-Charge of the Project. The Contractor shall ensure that there are no disruptions on the operation of the PS-DBM during the implementation of this project.

Project Duration

The contractor is given 45 calendar days upon receipt of the Notice to Proceed to perform and complete all the activities.

Penalty

In case of failure to complete the project within the time specified, a penalty of one-tenth of one percent (1/10 of 1%) of the total project cost for every day of delay shall be imposed.

Warranty

The contractor needs to submit a warranty certificate of at least five (5) years on compressors and one (1) year on parts and services for all the air conditioning units. The brand/manufacturer of the ACUs must have at least five (5) authorized service center in Metro Manila.

Also, the contractor shall perform preventive maintenance/cleaning of the ACU units at least two (2) times within its one (1) year warranty period.
