



Supply of Buses for the Davao High Priority Bus System (HPBS) Project

Contract No. 05 Bus Fleet – Diesel Vehicles Contract No. 06 Bus Fleet - Electric Vehicles

OCB 22-002-7

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1. The Government of the Republic of the Philippines has applied for financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of the Davao Public Transport Modernization Project. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the Contracts named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.

- 2. The Department of Transportation (DOTr) ("the Employer") through its Procuring Agent, Procurement Services - Department of Budget Management (PS-DBM), invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the supply of Goods and Services as broadly described above.
- **3.**Bidders may bid for a single contract only or for both contracts. In case the Bidder would wish to submit bids for more than one contract, such bids should be submitted independently and not combined into a single Bid.

In accordance with ITB 14.4 and ITB 14.6, any discounts offered by Bidders submitting bids for multiple contracts and the methodology for the application of any discount shall be stated in the Letter of Bid included in its bids for each contract.

The Employer shall evaluate and compare Bids on the basis of each contract separately or multiple contracts combined in order to arrive at the least-cost combinations for the Employer, by taking into account such discounts offered by Bidders for the award of multiple contracts.

4. The Employer's evaluation shall include an assessment of the Bidder's capacity to meet the following aggregated requirements as presented in the Bid:

- Contractual Experience
- Technical Experience
- Production Capacity
- Financial Situation

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5. Bidders' key qualifications are summarized in the Table below:





Qualification**

Bidder shall demonstrate:

1. Successful completion as main supplier within the last five (5) years, of at least three (3) contracts each valued at USD75 million with nature, and complexity similar to the scope of supply described in Section 6 (Schedule of Supply) for Contract No. 05.

2. Successful completion as main supplier within the last three (3) years, of at least two (2) contracts each valued at USD50 million with nature, and complexity similar to the scope of supply described in Section 6 (Schedule of Supply) for Contract No. 06.

Bidder shall demonstrate the goods offered have been in production for at least three (3) years.

Bidder shall demonstrate the goods offered have sold:

1. A minimum of 200 units (aggregate total of both vehicle types) of similar type and specification over the last three (3) years for Contract No. 05.

Production	The Bidder or manufacturer shall demonstrate that it can supply the type, size, and quantity of the goods as required by Purchaser in accordance with the Delivery and Completion Schedule in Section 6 (Schedule of Supply).
Capacity	[Ref: ITB Section 3: 2.3.3]
	Bidder shall demonstrate historic financial performance with the submission of audited financial statements or, if not required by the law of the Bidder's country, other financial statements acceptable to the Purchaser, for the last three (3)

years to demonstrate the current soundness of the Bidder's financial position.

As a minimum, the Bidder's net worth for the last year calculated as the difference between total assets and total liabilities should be positive.

Financial Situation

Bidder shall demonstrate a size of operation with a minimum average annual turnover of USD150 million calculated as total payments received by the Bidder for contracts completed or under execution over the last three (3) years.

Bidder shall demonstrate availability of or access to liquid assets, lines of credit, and other finances sufficient to meet cash flow minimum requirement which is USD50 million.

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6.Open competitive bidding will be conducted in accordance with ADB's Single-Stage: One-Envelope without Prequalification procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document.

8. To obtain the Bidding Document in English, eligible Bidders should: a. Download the Bidding Document, Tender Bulletins, Bid Addenda, Site Visit Information, etc. from the following websites:

To purchase hard copies of the Bidding Document in English, eligible bidders should write to the PS-DBM address above requesting the Documents for those Contracts for which they wish to submit a Bid.

b.Pay a non-refundable fee of Philippines Peso seventy-five thousand (PHP 75,000) for each set of Bidding Document required, by cashier's check made payable to "Procurement Service". Cash payment at the above address are acceptable subject to issuance of an authenticated official receipt.

For the avoidance of doubt, the non-refundable fee of PHP 75,000 shall be paid by a Bidder before submitting its bid regardless of whether the bidder obtains a hard copy of the Bidding Document or not. However, if a bidder requests for a hard copy, the PHP 75,000 shall be paid upon the bidder's request of the hard copy of the Bidding Document.

Procurement Service will hold a Pre-bid Conference on 08 April 2022 at 10:00AM (GMT+8) at the Procurement Service PS-DBM Compound, RR Road, Cristobal Street, Paco Manila 1007 Philippines which shall be open to all interested parties including those who have not purchased the Bidding Documents.

10.Bid(s) shall be delivered:

- On or before the deadline: 12 May 2022 at 10:00 AM (GMT+8)
- Together with the Bid Security as described in the Bidding Document.

Bids shall be opened in public in accordance with ITB 25 on the bid submission deadline stated above in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend.
