Dear Director Granados:

This refers to the following proposals of the Procurement Service (PS) through the memorandum dated February 20, 2014 regarding adoption of DBM Circular Letter No. 2013-16 Re: Expanded Modified Direct Payment Scheme (Expanded MDPS) for Accounts Payable (A/Ps):

- Exemption of the PS from being covered by the CL No. 2013-16, notwithstanding its still being a national government agency. The PS utilizes its internally generated funds to pay creditors through a Current Account, instead of an MDS account; and
- Issuance of an addendum to CL No. 2013-16 to prescribe the use of the List of Advances/Deposits-Advice to Debit Account (LAD-ADA) instead of the LDDAP-ADA, since CL No. 2013-16 specifically covers accounts payable.

Given the inherent advantages of the adoption of direct payment system thru the use of Advice to Debit Account (checkless payment system that allows efficient/timely payments of payables and elimination of outstanding checks), the DBM intends to expand this system to also cover other transactions of the government such as remittance of advances/deposits for planned procurement of supplies /equipment from the PS, which are **not** categorized as A/Ps.

Pending such guidelines, NGAs shall, in the meantime, continue to remit cash advances/deposits to the PS using MDS checks as usual. Further, with the PS not being a direct recipient of budgetary appropriations, you can continue to use your current account for the settlement of payables to suppliers/creditors.

Please be guided accordingly.
